

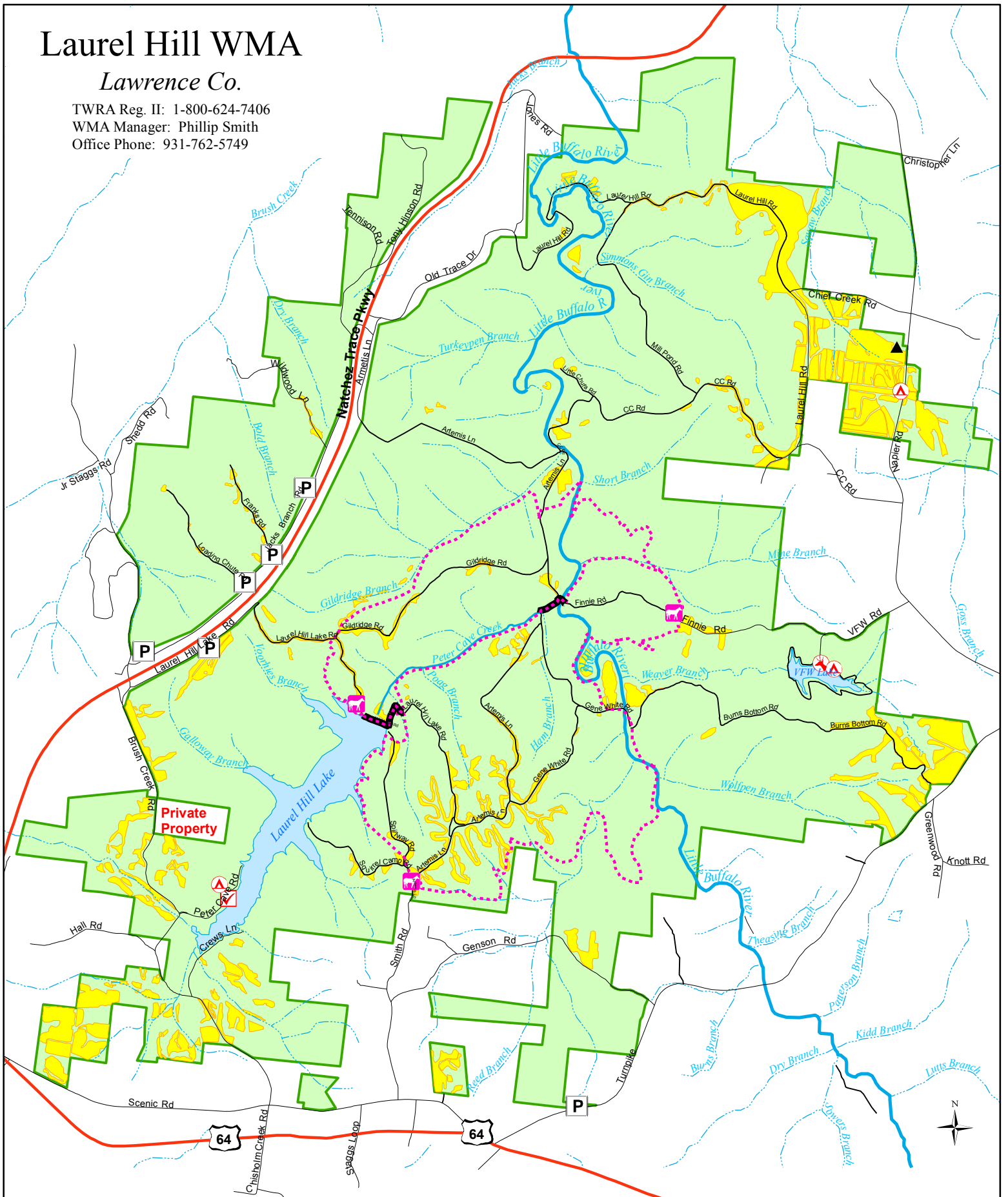

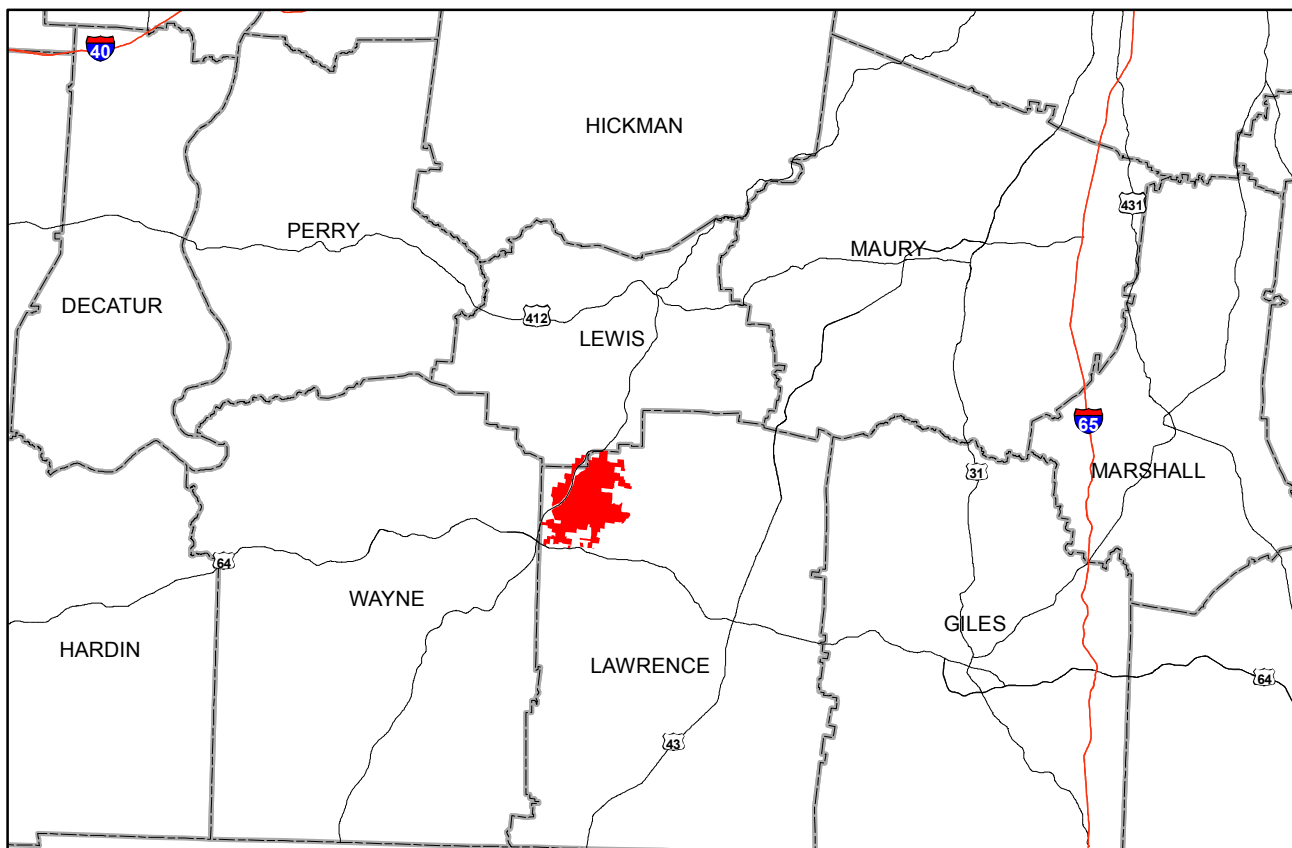

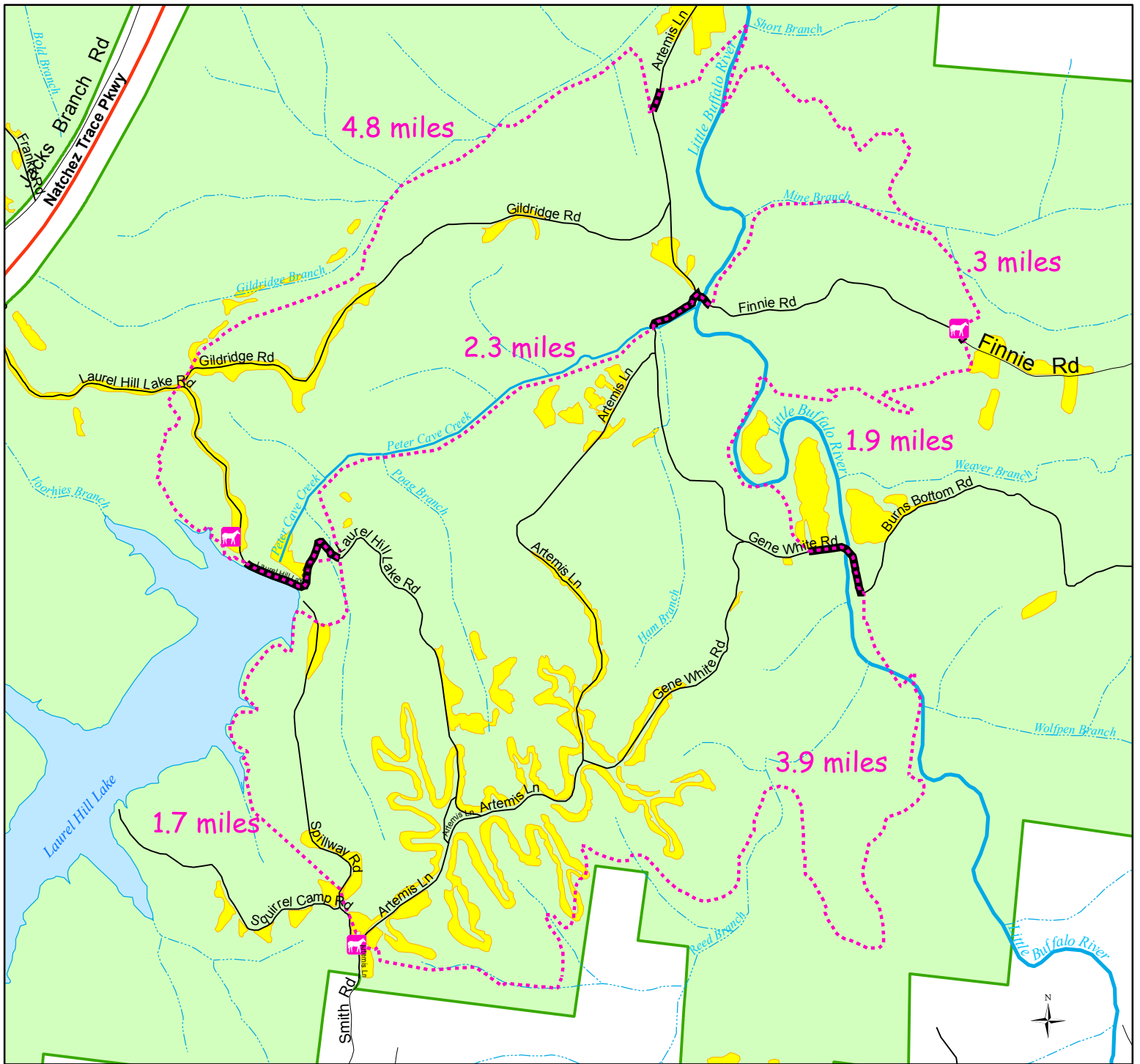

Horseback riding restricted to roads open to motorized traffic and designated trails. All horses must be ridden on designated trails or roads open to motorized vehicles. No fox chasing permitted. Unauthorized entry or presence is prohibited between sunset and sunrise. Small game hunting is closed at sunset the day before and during big game hunts.

See current Hunting and Trapping Guide for season dates and other regulations.













Rules and Regulation Governing Horse Trail Use

1. NO LITTERING.
2. All horse riders will stay on designated trails or roads.
3. No dogs allowed by trail riders.
4. Use and possession of alcohol prohibited.
5. No camping.
6. Trails open to riding in daylight hours only.
7. Trails closed to horseback riding one day before and during big-game deer hunts (check Hunting and Trapping Guide for dates).
8. Negative Coggins test required.
